#### InnoScot Health wants to support your ideas for pregnancy and perinatal innovation

A pregnancy and perinatal call from formal NHS Scotland partner InnoScot Health continues to welcome fresh ideas that it can support and help to develop.

Launched last year, the call is aiming to help NHS Scotland improve women's health by inspiring fresh ideas and new thinking from all health care staff, in turn promoting and supporting good child and maternal health.

Ideas that the organisation continues to support include:

- A skin-to-skin scrubs innovation for birthing partners developed by NHS Lothian's R&D team
- Technology for monitoring neonates when they are placed on a resuscitaire
- And technology for monitoring and controlling neonatal oxygen supply during retrieval events

InnoScot Health welcomes a wide spectrum of submissions – from innovations designed to improve labour and delivery, and improve outcomes for mothers with co-morbidities, to support for women experiencing mental health problems before and after delivery, and fresh ways to help bridge the gender health gap which can particularly affect mothers from socially disadvantaged backgrounds.

InnoScot Health's package of support for NHS Scotland staff includes support up to the value of £25k for initial seed funding, regulatory support, project management, and the extensive innovation expertise of its highly experienced team.

The call is expected to remain open for the foreseeable future so NHS Scotland staff are encouraged to <u>submit their</u> idea or book an online consultation to discuss taking their ideas forward with InnoScot Health experts.

The organisation welcome ideas – simple or complex – from any NHS health board and staff across all roles.
